Meet our Volunteers Theresia Yunita-Lichner

Tell a bit about yourself?

My name is Theresia Yunita-Lichner and I am Indonesian; I came to study

in Eindhoven in 2007 and have been living in Hoofddorp since 2009. After my study, I have been working in the Supply Chain Planning area. I am married to a German and have 2 daughters.

What do you do in our Parish?

I started as a volunteer in the English International Choir in Dec 2020; playing keyboard and singing. I remember that it was just a spontaneous idea from 3 people (Paula/Maya/myself), to sing in the English mass which just started at the time. As there were only a few people back then, we thought it would be nice to have a few Taize songs with guitar and make the service a bit "less" silent. Further, I am also a member of Maranatha choir which serves the Dutch mass.

What does your faith mean to you?

Faith to Jesus Christ in the Catholic church is my pillar in life. I feel blessed to be born in a Catholic family and learn about the faith. I started like any other child; we just do what our parents do and ask us to do. In Indonesia we learn and live our faith in everyday life, by praying, having the sacraments and serving communities. For me, my faith keeps my mind balanced between all the hustle in life and my spiritual needs.

What are your dreams for our parish?

Despite living in a very secular environment, I hope our parish still can be a place for people finding peace, hope and love from God; while maintaining the Catholic identity so that we still can transfer our faith especially to our children and the younger generations.

January 15th Feast of St. Arnold Janssen svd

Arnold Janssen, S.V.D. (5 November 1837 – 15 January 1909), was a German-Dutch Catholic priest and missionary who is venerated as a saint. He founded the Society of the Divine Word, a Catholic missionary religious congregation, also known as the Divine Word Missionaries, as well as two congregations for women. In 1889 he founded in Steyl, Netherlands, the Missionary Sisters Servants of the Holy Spirit and in 1896 at the same place the Holy Spirit Adoration Sisters. He was canonized on 5 October 2003, by Pope John Paul II. As of 2020, it consisted of 5,965 members composed of priests and religious brothers working in more than 70 countries, now part of VITA international. It is one of the largest missionary congregations in the Catholic Church.[10] Its members add the nominal letters SVD after their names to indicate membership in the Congregation. The superior general is Paulus Budi Kleden who hails from Indonesia.
