# Message from Seminarian, John Christian Caberoy

My name is John Christian Caberoy, I am 23 years old and I come from the Philippines. Starting last September 2023, I live in St. Willibrord Grootseminarie in Heiloo, the Netherlands. I am a seminarian and I already had finished my Philosophical Studies and received a Bachelors degree in Philosophy in St. Francis Xavier College Seminary of the Archdiocese of Davao, Philippines. Now, I am now in my first year as a seminarian in this Diocese, but this is already the 5th year of my formation.

Currently, I am assigned at St. Johannes de Doper Kerk, Hofddorp as an seminarian intern. Deacon Eugene Brussee asked me if I would want to be assigned in this place, and I said YES for this parish is somehow the start of my calling here in the Netherlands. Last 2018, during my vacation here in the Netherlands, I had the chance to meet Bp. Johannes Hendriks for the first time in this parish. He heard that I had a vocation for the priesthood and he gave me an option to start my study in the Willibrord seminary in Heiloo. But then, I preferred to go the seminary in my own country, because I thought it would be easier to study in an environment that is familiar.

However along the course of my formation, I had a change of heart and was able to accept the challenge of being a priest here in the Netherlands. Being away from the comfort of my own land is a challenging thing for you must adjust with the different culture, people, weather, and other unfamiliar things that you are used to. But, even amidst of these challenges, I am trusting of God's providence and guidance for He is the one who called me to be here.

My faith and vocation started with my family. My father is John and my mother is Christina, and I have two little sisters, Johanna and Janna. As a child we would go the parish every Sunday to attend mass. I remember joy of going to the church. What attracted me the most are the hymns in the mass, it made me active for it is pleasant to my ears and I wanted to sing through it, together with the people. I was not ashamed even though at times I just babble some words going through the music that I hear. As I grew up, my faith deepened, I came to understand more and more about the church. As I grew in faith, I was also able to see my vocation towards priesthood. My faith in God drives me all the way throughout my life as a Christian. It reminds me of my identity, of my being, and of the God who loves me. It helped me a lot to see more of the joy of this life, as well as of the lessons behind the trials that I experience. With my faith, I always try to hear more of God's calling, specially in this vocation to priesthood.

As Christians, we are called to be instruments of faith. We are to be the living witnesses of God's love and grace. Our words and actions are powerful for it may bring many people come to believe God. However, it is also by it that people may leave the church, through our misdeeds. Thus, as a Christian we should shed the light by being true to the word of the Lord, giving the people enough strength and hope to go on with their lives. And I think it can be good to start sowing these seeds of faith into our own families. Nurturing it on our children would be a great start. The children are the future of our church, therefore, let us strengthen our families by putting God as the center of it.
